#### **Main Tasks**

- Support and provide legal advice to the operational staff, sales representatives, and internal management.
- Ensure the analysis and the drafting of all legal agreements related to Group's projects (service contracts, software developments and license agreement, SaaS agreements, purchase and sales contracts, management mandates, confidentiality/non disclosure agreements, etc.) in support of the operational and sales teams.
- Be in charge of the legal/regulatory watch (national/EU laws applicable to, and likely to affect, the operation of our business and/or entity(ies)) with the help of the BNPP AM Legal team.
- Guarantee the correct application of the Legal procedures and policies set by the Group
- Ensure the corporate housekeeping to ensure the adequate preparation and follow-ups of the board of directors' and shareholder(s) meetings
- · Act as secretary to the Board of Directors, inter alia in ensuring meetings are effectively organised and minuted and in maintaining effective records and administration (agenda, minutes taking, send-outs, etc)
- · Select, appoint, and oversee external lawyers in relation to any relevant legal matters (including, as the case may be, any pre-litigation or dispute), in accordance with the applicable procedure(s).
